Athens Arts4All is a two-day, juried arts and crafts festival designed to allow visitors of all ages to experience, participate in and enjoy all forms of art. Artisans, music acts, food vendors and students come together to sell, create and be inspired. Activities include artisan displays, performances, student art shows, kids activities, clay demonstrations and make-and-take art classes. The selected vendors will enjoy a friendly atmosphere including free continental breakfast, easy set up and tear down, change bank and helpful volunteers throughout the festival. Advertising will be extensive including radio, newspapers, TV and social media. This show is a combination of indoor and outdoor spaces with room for over 150 artisans. Mark it on your calendar and plan to join us!

Eligibility requirements:

- All work must be handcrafted by the applicant. NO commercially produced merchandise, kits, items assembled from commercially available parts, or merchandise created with commercial molds may be sold. No items resembling weapons will be permitted. Additional restrictions may be required by the Arts4All committee.
- All displayed items must be priced and available for purchase.
- Athens Arts4All personnel reserve the right to determine the eligibility of all work submitted for jurying.
- Only work submitted for jurying may be exhibited in each booth.
- Space requests will be considered, but can not be guaranteed.
- Booths are individual and only for the selected artisan. No sharing of booths.
- Acceptance in the current year does not guarantee future acceptance.
- All artisans are required to carry insurance as noted on the application.
- All artisans are required to stay for the entire show. No early set ups or tear downs.
- Applications must be submitted in a business-sized envelope with a self-addressed, stamped return envelope, at least 4 photographs for jury purposes including at least 2 of work, 1 of table display and 1 of the artisans creating the work. Work in more than one media may be presented per artisan, but all media must be represented to the jury. If you were part of Arts4All in 2019, we have photographs of your booth/work. If you have not made significant changes, you do not need to submit a new photographs.
- Applications are due no later than January 17, 2020. Late applications will be placed on a waiting list.

Insurance requirements

The artisan must agree to secure and maintain the following minimum insurance coverages throughout the event:

General Liability Aggregate\$1,000,000Property Damage\$300,000 per occurrenceOr \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit.

The artisan agrees to name Athens Arts4All (122 South Hopkins Street, Sayre, PA 18840) and Athens Area School District (100 Canal Street, Athens, PA 18810) as "additional insured".

If you do not currently carry insurance on your business, you can inquire about additional coverage through your homeowner's policy. For an affordable, three day event policy (about \$40), the ACT Insurance Program option is available online for artists, crafters and tradespeople. The Athens Arts4All is not affiliated with the ACT Insurance Program and is simply providing this information as a courtesy.

Artisans are required to submit proof of insurance after you receive acceptance notification and before the actual event. If insurance information is not provided, the artisan will not be allowed to set up.
